Dear Dr. Hocanin:

At their October 27-28, 2022 meeting, the directors of the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) reviewed the Visiting Team Report for Eastern Mediterranean University's International Certification.

On behalf of the directors of the Board, it is my pleasure to inform you that the Bachelor of Architecture (158 credits) degree offered by the Department of Architecture has been granted continuation of NAAB International Certification for a term of six years, effective January 1, 2022. Eastern Mediterranean University's next visit will be held in 2028.

Consistent with the *2019 Procedures for NAAB International Certification*, all programs with Visiting Team Reports that identify 'not-met' Student Performance Criteria are required to submit an Interim Progress Report (IPR). Your program is required to submit an IPR to address the program's progress in correcting the not-met Student Performance Criteria identified in the 2022 Visiting Team Report on or before **November 30, 2025**. The NAAB will provide a template for the report under a separate cover on or before March 30, 2025.

Further, the program is required to make the following documents available, in their entirety, on the Eastern Mediterranean University website:

- 2022 Visiting Team Report (attached)
- Program Self-Evaluation Report prepared for the 2022 visit
- 2019 Conditions for NAAB International Certification
- 2019 Procedures for NAAB International Certification
